
SkyTouch / Arches Walker



- SkyTouch, a remote control of Aladin through SAMP shown in CoSADIE TechForum 2 by Maxime Heckel
- The prototype will be the basis of the work package 13 (Outreach) of the FP7 Arches project (ARCHES - Astronomical Resource Cross-matching for High Energy Studies).
- « Arches Walker » should be a smart and easy to use architecture for education, planetariums, etc.
- Development starts in April (Laurent Michel, André Schaaff and an intern).










New work around user interfaces and interactions



- We have started a work around the Oculus
- Preliminary phase has started
 - $_{\circ}~$ Use cases definition : for astronomer and for Education / Outreach
- Steps from March to August
 - Test and learn the Oculus development kit, prototype a few examples
 - Development of 2 « robust » use cases, one for astronomers (simulations, HEALPix surveys, etc.) and one for the Education / Outreach
- Participants : CDS, IMCCE (Jérôme Berthier and Jonathan Normand for SkyBot 3D), Planétarium de Strasbourg, 3 interns



SAVOT



- SAVOT (Simple Access to VOTable (Java)) has been refurbished for the coming release 4.0
- It is now maintained by André Schaaff and Laurent Bourgès (LAOG)
- A Javascript version should be developed after the Java release
